Donation to Friends of the Owyhee will aid litter removal, promote recreation in area

Clackamas, Ore. -- The Oregon Beverage Recycling Cooperative (OBRC), parent organization to [BottleDrop](#), announced a \$1,000 donation to Friends of the Owyhee, an Ontario, Ore. based nonprofit promoting conservation advocacy, stewardship, and responsible recreation in the Owyhee region. The donation, generated through BottleDrop's [Containers for Change](#) program, will be used by the nonprofit to support their ongoing litter removal and recreation promotion efforts in Owyhee Canyon.

"These funds will support our work in the Owyhee Canyon below Lake Owyhee, focusing primarily on cleaning up trash along the river and creating recreation information about the Lower Owyhee to create a better visitor experience."
