

BottleDrop Express vs. Dealer Redemption Center

What is a BottleDrop Express (BDE) and a Dealer Redemption Center (DRC)?

Both BDEs and DRCs are retail sites that offer our customers various BottleDrop services, including access to return deposit containers and BottleDrop account funds, Green Bags, and kiosks. The most notable differences between the two location types are who carries the bag processing fee, the number of bags a customer can return, and the quantity of containers an individual can return daily.

What are the distinguishing characteristics of BDEs and DRCs?

BottleDrop Express

- Bag drop open 7am - 10pm
- Requirement to accept 144 individual containers per person, per day
- Limit 15 bags dropped per account, per quarter
- Customer is responsible for bag processing fee
- Retailer is responsible for site and core hardware costs

Dealer Redemption Center

- Bag drop open from 8am-8pm
- Requirement to accept only 24 individual containers per person, per day
- Bags do not count towards quarterly bag limit
- Retailer may limit to 15 bags per day
- Retailer is responsible for bag processing and transportation costs
- Retailer is responsible for site preparation and core hardware costs
