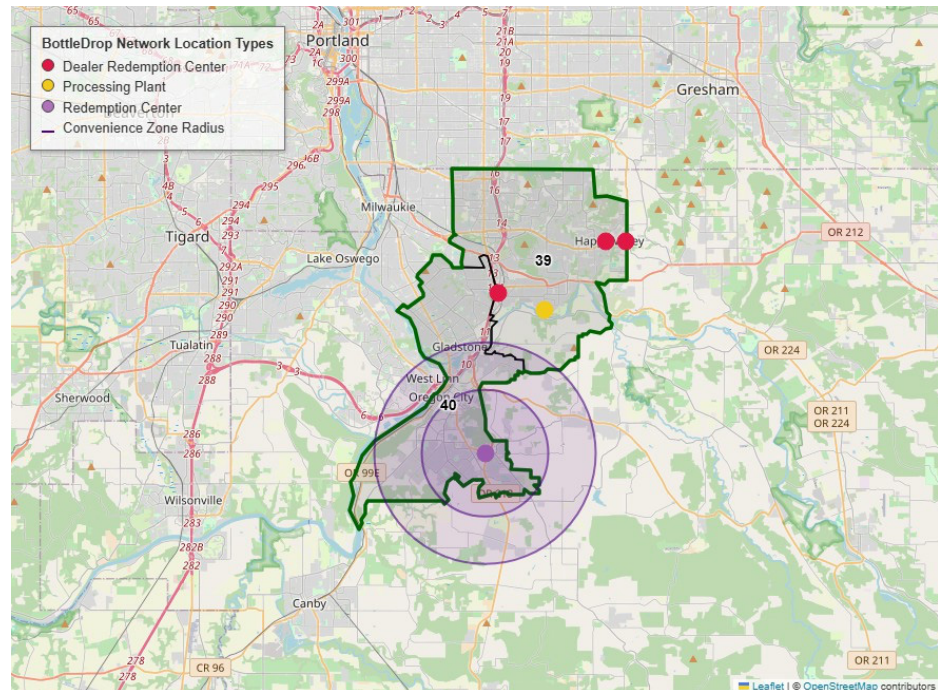

Executive Summary

This inaugural report cycle launches our biannual legislative district reports series, created to celebrate progress and provide a more community-focused view of beverage container redemption activity across Oregon.

The first half of 2025 was a landmark period for OBRC. We proudly helped pass SB 992, ushering in key modernizations for Oregon's Bottle Bill. Implementation kicked off immediately, setting the stage for long-term improvements. In partnership with retailers, we launched five new Green and Blue Bag drop sites in Port Orford, Brookings, Hillsboro, Happy Valley and Beaverton – expanding convenience for communities across Oregon. Statewide, we're thrilled to see a growing shift toward bag returns, reflecting the success of these efforts.

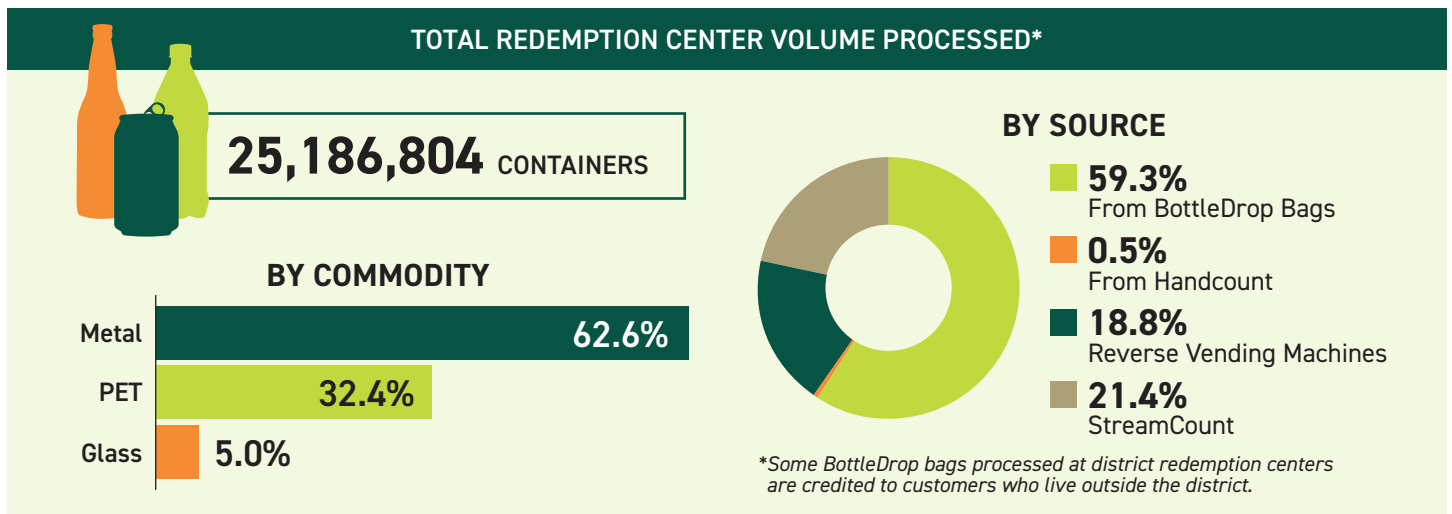

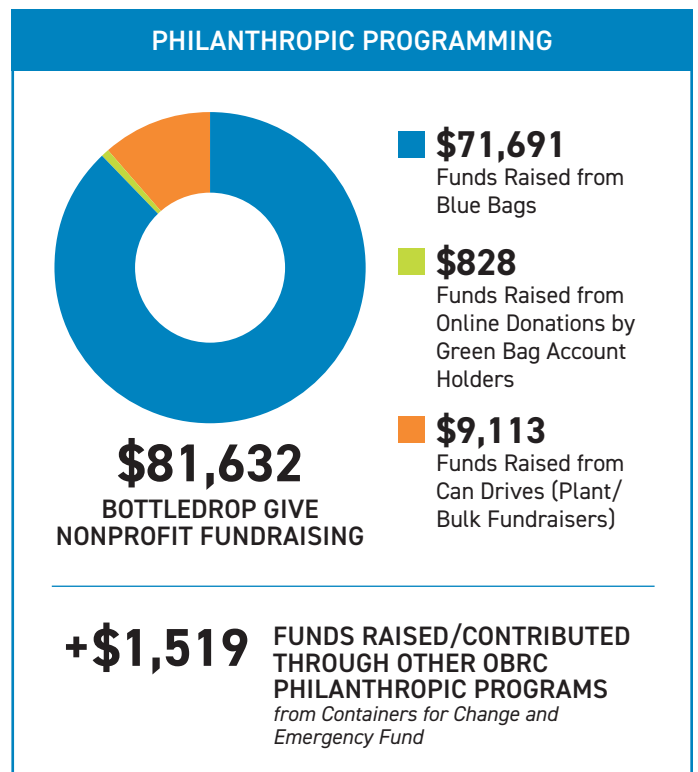
